From the earliest, the Italian painter Guiseppe Arcimboldo was best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of objects such as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish and books. More contemporary pop artists of the day have made art all about food. Roy Lichtenstein created Cherry Pie in 1962 along with other iconic food images which he would become famous for depicting. Andy Warhol would go on to paint his iconic banana and a Campbells soup can, while Wayne Thiebaud created Cakes in 1963, Display Cakes in 1963, Cake Slice in 1979, Cake Rows in 1962 and countless other artworks all depicting sweet confectioners delights!
